## Ultra marathoner runs 240 miles in four days to benefit two 9/11 charities

**Arlington, VA, September 2, 2014** – Over the course of four days, Jeremy Boyd of Cary NC, will run 240 miles from the Pentagon to Ground Zero. The purpose of his run is to honor and support people directly impacted by the events of September 11, 2001, by raising funds for two charities that provide support services for survivors. Jeremy hopes “People will think I am crazy, and out of curiosity, be intrigued enough to investigate my cause.”

Jeremy will start his journey on September 8 at 6 am at the Pentagon. His route will take him through towns and cities in Maryland, Delaware, Pennsylvania, New Jersey and New York. He hopes to arrive at the 9/11 Memorial around 6:15 pm on September 11. Anyone wanting to run (or ride) with Jeremy for a mile or 50 is welcome to join him as he will be averaging roughly 60 miles per day. The Special Operations Warrior Foundation ensures full financial assistance for a post secondary degree from an accredited two or four-year college, university, technical, or trade school; as well as educational and family counseling to the surviving children of Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine Corps special operations personnel who lose their lives in the line of combat duty. It also provides immediate financial assistance to severely-wounded and hospitalized special operations personnel and their families

“We are privileged to be a beneficiary of the Run to Never Forget, which will honor those we lost on September 11, 2001,” said Vice Admiral and Navy SEAL (Ret.) Joe Maguire, president of the Special Operations Warrior Foundation.

“The funds Jeremy raises will help us ensure full college tuition to the families of special operators who die in the line of duty, and provide immediate financial assistance to our wounded Special Operations Forces,” Maguire said.
